PARISH ANNOUNCEMENT

On 17th February, 2019, the Bishop of Southwark announced the following appointments:

Reverend Annie Kurk as Team Vicar of Whyteleafe & Chaldon

Reverend Helen Burnett as Associate Vicar of Whyteleafe & Chaldon

They will each work for approximately half the normal week, and will be remunerated accordingly. Revd Annie will live in the Whyteleafe Vicarage, Revd Helen will continue to live in her own home in Reigate.

The details of the working arrangements have yet to be worked out and agreed between them. However, it is likely that Revd Annie will focus more on the parish of Whyteleafe and Revd Helen will focus more on the parish of Chaldon. But they will seek to ensure that the close relationship that has developed between the two parishes is fostered.

The arrangements for their licensing have yet to be confirmed.



Reverend Annie Kurk is currently employed as the Chaplain of St Cecilia's Church of England School in Southfields. She is also an Assistant Vicar at St Barnabas, Clapham Common (non-stipendiary). She is a member of

the Southwark Diocesan Board of Education.

Reverend Helen joined the Caterham Team nearly three years ago as an Assistant Curate (non-stipendiary).

Most of her training has involved the congregations at Whyteleafe and Chaldon, who are delighted at her continued involvement with these parishes.

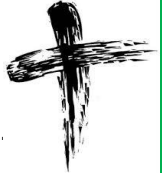


We would like to invite everyone who currently leads or might consider leading intercessions at St Luke's to a Lenten lunch at Chaldon.
